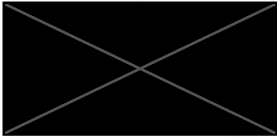




Dear Ms. D'Andre:

I am responding to your recent letter dated March 22, 2017 in regards to your request for public records for the Colorado Child Support Services (CSS) Program. The information the Colorado CSS Program can provide is very limited due to confidentiality rules and regulations. Also, some data is not available without an extensive build in our data system which is not cost effective to our program. Therefore, we are unable to provide some of the information you have requested. We are able to provide you with the number of open CSS cases in Colorado, which are 150,131 cases as of February 28, 2017. This number consists of cases that owe current support only, current and arrears support, and arrears support only. The Colorado CSS Program only collects on current child support and arrears owed. We do not collect interest on arrears owed unless a party reduces the interest to a judgment or another state that collects interest on their orders requests Colorado to enforce their order.
