**SUBJECT: PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST**

Dear Ms. D'Andre:

On March 6, 2017 and March 28, 2017, the California State Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) received your request for public records, dated February 27, 2017 and March 22, 2017, respectively, in which you request copies of the following:

1. The number of open cases with the Child Support Program in the State.
2. The top 100 cases with the highest balances due in the State.
3. Clarification whether the amount due is support or support plus interest?

Enclosed please find copies of comparative data charts for Federal Fiscal Year 2016, which was published in January of 2017. In response to your first query, Table 1.2 gives the total number of statewide cases with support orders established, in addition to the numbers per each county. Table 6.4 shows cases with current support due.

With regard to your second query, Table 1.3 provides the amount of collections on current support orders. Table 1.4 provides the number of cases with an arrears balance and Table 7.2 shows the amount of arrears balances due based on case type. As to your third query, amounts stated for current orders are only for monthly support amounts. Arrears amounts include past due support plus interest. The figures in these tables are based on cumulative case data in the system.

As you and I discussed, a document containing the 100 highest case balances is not a public record in existence but I am working with our technical team to determine how we can devise a search for this information. I will provide you an update upon obtaining additional information in this regard. If you have further questions in the interim, you may contact me at (916) 464-5181.
