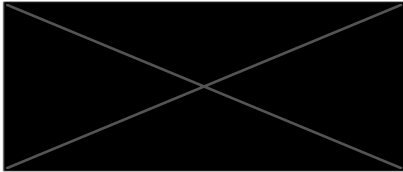

**Re: New Mexico Inspection of Public Records Act Request**


Dear Ms. D'Andre:

This letter is in response to your public records request, received on February 17, 2017, in which you requested:

- “1. The number of open cases with the Child Support Program in the State.
2. The top 100 cases with the highest balances due in the State. For example, #1 – \$1+ million, #2 – \$975k and so on.
3. Clarification on the amount due. Does it represent support due or support plus interest (if in judgment).”

The Human Services Department has no documents responsive to the second or third parts of your request. Pursuant to the Inspection of Public Records Act, Section 14-2-8(B), a state agency is not required to create a public record in response to a request.
